



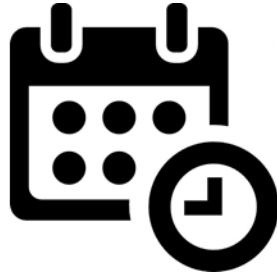

Why Extended Access?

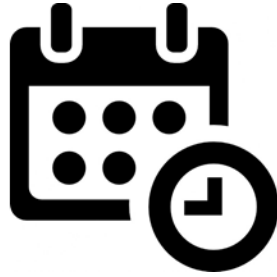
The public are telling the NHS that they can't access their GP Practice when they need to, Extended Access hopes to try and address this



What is Extended Access?

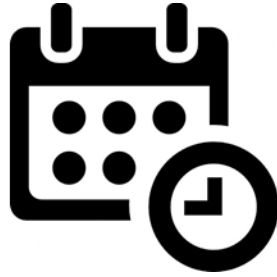
The Extended Access Service is made up of four key benefits for Doncaster Patients:

- Additional Saturday morning appointments offered locally
- Appointments for a physio assessment
- More GP and Nurse appointments on the day
- Drop in clinics for vulnerable groups such as homeless, new migrants, sex workers



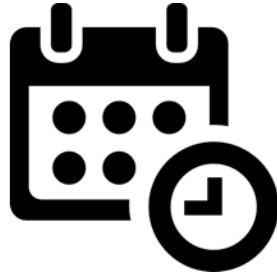
Saturday Morning Appointments

- Appointments will be available at the four hub sites across Doncaster:
 - **The Lakeside Practice**
 - **Thorne Moor Medical Practice**
 - **Conisbrough Group Practice**
 - **Tickhill and Colliery Medical Practice**
 - White Wings Centre, Askern
 - The Vermuyden Centre, Thorne
 - Stone Castle Centre, Conisbrough
 - St Mary's Road, Tickhill
- Appointments are available between 9am and 12pm every Saturday morning
- Appointments are booked by your usual GP practice reception in advance



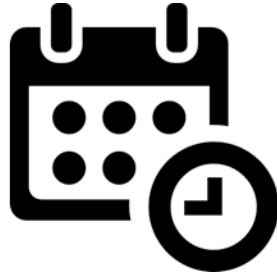
First 2 Physio Appointments

- Appointments are with a qualified physiotherapist without the need to see your GP first
- Appointments are available at the Same Day Health Centre, Devonshire House, Doncaster
- You will be assessed, given advice and a home exercise program if required
- Appointments are available throughout the week and at the weekend
- Appointments are booked by your usual GP practice reception



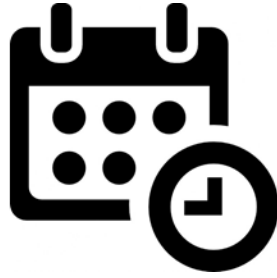
More 'on the day' Appointments

- Your GP Practice can offer you more early morning and evening appointments on the day
- These extra appointments will be based at the Same Day Health Centre, Devonshire House
- Appointments are booked by your usual GP practice reception



Inclusion Health Clinics

- Drop in clinics for vulnerable groups such as new migrants, asylum seekers, homeless and sex workers
- Weekly GP and Nurse clinics are based at:
 - Wharf House 1pm – 4pm every Wednesday
 - The Conversation Club 1pm – 4pm every Thursday
 - Changing Lives Centre 1pm – 4pm every Thursday
- Clinics emphasise attending and signposting usual GP or mainstream services
